## Voronezh State University (Russia), Faculty of Romance and Germanic Philology

The Forum aims to bring together researchers from the humanities and social sciences to examine the key issues and challenges associated with communication across language and culture boundaries in our changing world. It will open up space for the exchange of ideas on intercultural communication and cross-cultural dialogue from a wide range of the human sciences, including linguistics, literature, law and politics, philosophy, psychology, social and cultural studies, pedagogical studies and related disciplines.

The event will bring together scholars, early career researches and language practitioners from Russia and across the world to explore linguistic challenges in such areas as socio-cultural studies, multiculturalism, European multilingualism, interpreting and translation, identity, project management and internationalisation of higher education.

We invite proposals for presentations in any of these or related fields.

The conference will include keynote presentations and plenary talks, five topical sections for individual presentations, workshops, and will provide a forum for showcasing the latest language learning resources and research publications.

Each topical section will provide a platform for researchers, practitioners and educators to present and discuss their findings on topics related, but not limited, to:

Section 1. Linguistics and Intercultural Communication

Section 2. Interpreting and Translation Studies: current approaches and evolving perspectives

Section 3. The future of language teaching: innovative strategies and new practices

Section 4. Multiculturalism against a backdrop of social and political integration

- Section 5. Young Researchers Symposium including
  - Conference session on Linguistics and Digital Technologies
  - Student Research Paper Competition
  - Translation Competition

The Young Researchers Symposium is designed to give postgraduate and undergraduate students with an interest in linguistics from all research areas an opportunity to present and discuss their research in a friendly and intellectually stimulating setting.

## The conference languages are Russian, English, French, Spanish, Italian and German

### **Registration fee**

The full registration fee is 1,500 Rub. The fee covers access to all sessions and publication costs. Forum fees are waived for young researches.

#### **Certificate of participation and publication**

All participants will receive a Certificate of participation and the papers will be later published in the Conference Proceedings or the Voronezh University *Journal of Linguistics and Intercultural Communication.*
